THE FREE APPLICATION FOR FEDERAL STUDENT AID (FAFSA) IS NOW OPEN AND LCHS IS BRINGING IN A SPECIALIST.

PARENTS AND STUDENTS CAN COME AND BEGIN THE APPLICATION AND GET QUESTIONS ANSWERED. YOU MAY NOT HAVE ALL OF THE DOCUMENTS NEEDED YET, BUT YOU CAN COME TO START THE APPLICATION, THEN SAVE YOUR APPLICATION TO COMPLETE LATER.

WHAT IS FAFSA?: FAFSA CAN OFFER GRANTS (FREE MONEY), LOANS AT GOOD INTEREST RATES, WORK STUDY, AND COLLEGES USE IT TO DETERMINE WHAT SCHOLARSHIPS THEY WILL OFFER YOU

HERE IS WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING FOR FAFSA (FAFSA.GOV):

STUDENT'S SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, MOTHER'S SSN, FATHER'S SSN, IF NOT A US CITIZEN, ALIEN REGISTRATION NUMBER, STUDENT'S 2017 FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURN, W-2, PARENT'S 2017 FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURN, W-2S, (BANK STATEMENTS AND RECORDS OF INVESTMENTS RECORDS OF UNTAXED INCOME IF APPLICABLE)

AB 540 ELIGIBLE STUDENTS (ATTENDED CA HIGH SCHOOL FOR 3 YEARS, GRADUATED, AND ENROLLED IN CA COLLEGE) WHO DO NOT HAVE A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, OR WERE ISSUED AN SSN THROUGH DACA SHOULD COMPLETE THE DREAM ACT APPLICATION. THE DREAM ACT APPLICATION IS FOR STUDENTS WHO WANT TO APPLY FOR CALIFORNIA FINANCIAL AID AND THIS MAY INCLUDE UNDOCUMENTED STUDENTS, STUDENTS WHO ARE US CITIZENS, BUT WHO ARE NOT RESIDENTS OF CA, AND DEPENDENT STUDENTS WHOSE PARENTS ARE NOT RESIDENTS OF CA.

TO COMPLETE THE CALIFORNIA DREAM ACT APPLICATION (CADAA), YOU WILL NEED: STUDENT'S 2017 FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURN, W-2S, PARENT'S 2017 FEDERAL INCOME TAX RETURN, W-2S, (BANK STATEMENTS AND RECORDS OF INVESTMENTS, RECORDS OF UNTAXED INCOME IF APPLICABLE)
